Day 2: Sat 25th October 2008 Multi Day Long Distance (NWOC)

Map: Woodhill, Beautiful Hills

Scale 1:10,000, Contours 5m. Setter: Paul Ireland, Controller: Mark Lawson

Starts from 11.00 am

Day 3: Sun 26th October 2008 Multi Day Long Distance (NWOC)

Map: Woodhill, White Lightning (adjoins the area to be used for 2009 NZ Middle Dist. Champs)

Points System:

Three days out of the four count towards your final score, discarding your worst day. Day one is a chasing start double race, however it will be the days result overall counted as a days result for this day. You may enter different classes on the different days, but you must nominate which class is your competitive class for the 4-day tally. If you have entered different classes for any day of the event, you will need to circle the grade that you nominate as your competitive class.

Closing Date for Entries:

Closing date for entries is Friday 10th October 2008. Later entries will be accepted at organisers' discretion. There may be extra maps available for entries on the day, but not necessarily on the course of your choice.
